Reconfirmation Meeting for May 2021

Reconfirm instructional delivery method:

Face-to-face with the exception of any of the following:

1. state or regional order requiring remote learning
2. significant number and/or length of staff and/or student quarantines within programs
3. local districts mandate remote learning only for their students
4. Area School parental request for remote learning from January 4, 2021 through the end of the 2020-21 school year

Reconfirm how instruction will be delivered for each grade level:

Area School: Face-to-Face

CTE: Face-to-Face

Reconfirm whether or not the district is offering higher levels of in-person instruction for English language learners, special education students, or other special populations:

If CTE is remote only, arrangements may be made for small groups of students with special education needs or poor internet connections to learn face-to-face. In addition, if allowed by MDHHS and MDE, CTE students in skilled trades programs that require hands-on learning and testing for certifications will be allowed for face-to-face learning and testing in small groups while observing COVID safety protocols.
